### **bowdlerize.**

Main Entry: **bowd·ler·ize**

Pronunciation: 'b0d-l&-"rIz, 'baud-

Function: *transitive verb*

Inflected Form(s): **-ized; -iz·ing**

Etymology: Thomas *Bowdler* died 1825 English editor

Date: 1826

**1** : to expurgate (as a book) by omitting or modifying parts considered vulgar

**2** : to modify by abridging, simplifying, or distorting in style or content
